Attia Fatma is Emeritus Professor at the National Water Research Center in Egypt Director of the Water Boards Project; and advisor to the Minister on groundwater management issues.

Dr Fatma's principal experience lies in the implementation of water resources management and groundwater; development of systems and organisational structure to suit various cultural and working conditions in the country, e.g. water users in the oases, wadis.

Dr Fatma obtained a PhD in Groundwater Hydrology from Cairo University and has held several positions in the Ministry of Water Resources and Irrigation where she played key roles in groundwater management.

She serves on various advisory boards of international and regional projects and has been a consultant for various national, regional and international agencies in the field of groundwater management and integrated water management.
